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



Our product is graded by color, size and hardness, and we can offer a selection of both natural and treated (stabilized) stones.

Our stones are called "Anmoruk", which in Armenian means the Forget-Me-Not flower, the color of which our turquoise is similar to.



HOW WE SORT OUR STONES

SIZES:

1 & 2		5 - 10 mm
3		15 - 20 mm
4		25 - 30 mm
5		30 - 35 mm
6		35 - 40 mm
7		40 - 55 mm
8 & 9		55 - 60+ mm

HARDNESSES:

“NATURAL” – The hardness of these stones allows you to cut and turn them into ready products without stabilization or other treatment.

“HARD CHALK” – These stones are softer than the “Natural” ones, and require treatment before cutting or polishing, however some types of shapes can be cut without threatening the stones.

“CHALK” - These stones have the lowest hardness and they have to undergo special treatment before being cut.

“STABILIZED” – We can stabilize stones of any of the aforementioned grade prior to shipping to our customers upon request. We do not manipulate the stone color during the treatment and only use it to improve cutting and polishing qualities of the stone.

COLORS:



BLUE

The most sought after color of turquoise in the world which Nature has given us and which we are proud to introduce.



DEEP BLUE

The rarest, bluest and hardest stones that can only be found in our mine.



LIGHT GREEN

Blue with a slight green accent. The pictures will help you understand the difference.



RARE COLORS
